Galápagos Islands & South America

Stunning colour and extraordinary scenery define South America. Peak Travel Periods

May–September is ideal for visiting Machu Picchu and the Amazon, offering dry conditions and excellent wildlife viewing. The Galápagos Islands are a year-round destination, with peak demand from **June–September** and **December–January**.

Expert Advice

For fewer crowds at Machu Picchu, travel in **April–May**. In the Galápagos, **December–May** offers superb snorkelling visibility. The Amazon's wet season from **December–May** allows for deeper exploration by boat into the flooded rainforest.

DAYS 1-3

Lima + Sacred Valley

Begin in Lima, Peru's vibrant capital and discover the city's many faces on a guided tour that reveals its blend of history, culture and contemporary life. You'll then fly from Lima to Cusco and transfer to the breathtaking Sacred Valley of the Incas. Take in the spectacular tapestry of terraced hillsides, winding rivers, and charming villages nestled between towering peaks.

DAYS 4-6

Sacred Valley + Machu Picchu

Get to know Chinchero, a picturesque village celebrated for its weaving traditions, before setting off on your Machu Picchu adventure. Discover sacred temples and the vast agricultural terraces, then soak in the quiet majesty of Machu Picchu. Bid farewell and board the train for your return journey to Cusco, carrying unforgettable memories of one of the world's most mystical sites.

DAYS 7-10

Cusco + Guayaquil or Quito

Delve deeper into the heart of Cusco, and learn the history and spiritual significance of this awe-inspiring Incan cultural centre. Fly to Ecuador, arriving in either Quito, the Andean capital, or the coastal city of Guayaquil. Transfer to *National Geographic Endeavour II*, where your voyage begins.

DAY 11-16

DAYS 1-2

Quito + Coca + Yasuni National Park

In Quito, ascend El Panecillo for breathtaking panoramic views of the city and surrounding volcanoes. Fly from Quito to Coca, gateway to the Ecuadorian Amazon, where your journey into the rainforest begins. Take in the ever-changing scenery, before boarding your river cruise and continue navigating winding waterways deeper into this remarkable ecosystem.

DAYS 3-5

Yuturi Lake + Pañacocha + Añangu

Spend your days exploring the Napo River. Keep watch for a variety of wildlife as you venture into Yasuní National Park, including the legendary pink river dolphin. Gain insight into rich cultural heritage, shared firsthand by the Kichwa people, and take part in a hands-on cooking lesson onboard. Enjoy guided walks through the Amazon rainforest, where your naturalist will introduce you to the diverse plants and wildlife that thrive in this unique ecosystem.

DAYS 6-7

Coca + Quito

In the morning, disembark and travel by motorised canoe along the river to Coca Airport, where your onward flight to Quito awaits. You'll then fly to the Galápagos Islands, where you will be escorted to *National Geographic Endeavour II* and your extraordinary expedition journey begins.

DAYS 8-13

Galápagos Islands

Walk among wildlife unfazed by your presence, snorkel in crystal-clear waters teeming with marine life, and witness beautiful ecosystems. Each day brings a curated selection of islands, offering opportunities to encounter iconic species in their

natural habitats, from marine iguanas basking on volcanic shores to Galápagos penguins and fur seals, cruising along the coast.

DAYS 14-15

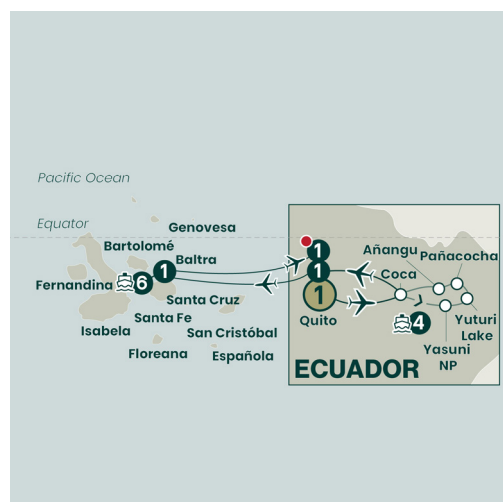

Antarctica & South America

Peak Travel Periods

November–March is the Antarctic expedition season, with **January–February** bringing peak wildlife activity. Argentina is best visited between **October–December** offering mild weather, fewer crowds, and vibrant city life.

Expert Advice

For dramatic scenery and fewer travellers, visit Antarctica early in the season. **December–January** offers long daylight hours, ideal for extended excursions.

Buenos Aires + Ushuaia

DAYS 1-4

Begin in Buenos Aires, exploring its cosmopolitan blend of European elegance and Latin American culture, before flying to Ushuaia. Sandwiched between ice-mantled peaks and the frigid waters of the Beagle Channel, this is where you will board *National Geographic Explorer*, ready to sail off to the White Continent.

Drake Passage

DAYS 5-6

Feel the excitement build as you traverse the Drake Passage, an 800 kilometre stretch separating South America from the Antarctic Peninsula. Keep watch for sightings of whales and dolphins as you journey into Antarctica's remote and untouched environment.

Antarctica

DAYS 7-10

Explore the remote landscapes of Antarctica through whale sightings, penguin encounters and evening Zodiac cruises beneath the midnight sun. Navigate icebergs, glaciers and pack ice at close range, with options for kayaking and shore excursions. Throughout, expert guides and the ship's captain ensure safe passage while revealing the region's extraordinary wildlife and scenery. Wherever you go in Antarctica, you'll be surrounded by opportunities to capture uniquely beautiful images. Along the way your expert expedition team will enrich your experiences.

King George Island + Puerto Natales

DAY 11

Anchor off King George Island, home to a diverse array of wildlife and several international research stations. Disembark and Zodiac to the shoreline where you will transfer to your flight back to

Puerto Natales, concluding your Antarctic adventure.

Puerto Natales + Torres del Paine National Park

DAYS 12-15

Stay at Estancia Cerro Guido, a historic Patagonian ranch set on the edge of Torres del Paine National Park, a place home to jaw dropping landscapes, from towering granite peaks and dramatic glaciers to turquoise lakes and emerald-green forests. Experience authentic gaucho life through ranch activities, then explore the park's iconic scenery on foot, horseback or guided excursions. Join a conservation safari to learn about puma tracking and local wildlife protection, before concluding with a transfer to Puerto Natales for departure, taking with you unforgettable memories of a once-in-a-lifetime journey.

Expedition to Antarctica & Iguazú

Buenos Aires

Discover the iconic neighbourhoods, historic plazas and vibrant districts, that define Buenos Aires complemented by an authentic tango performance and immersive gaucho experience in the Pampas.



+ Go further: Sip and savour Palermo

Discover Palermo on a culinary walk through Buenos Aires' most vibrant neighbourhood. Taste vermouth and regional wines, enjoy classic Argentine dishes and finish with dulce de leche, while exploring street art, culture and daily porteño life.

DAYS 1-3

Iguazú Falls + Ushuaia

Continue to the awe-inspiring Iguazú Falls, staying within the national park to explore rainforest trails, thundering cascades and panoramic viewpoints from both the Argentine and Brazilian sides. Fly onward to Ushuaia, where wildlife, including sea lions, set the stage for the onward Antarctic expedition aboard *National Geographic Endurance*.

DAYS 4-7

Drake Passage

Cross the legendary Drake Passage, the 800 kilometre wide strait between South America and the Antarctic Peninsula. Watch for seabirds such as wandering albatross, and possibly whales or dolphins. On board, explore the ship and join expert-led talks, as you prepare for the journey ahead into Antarctica's remote and extraordinary environment.

DAYS 8-9

Antarctica

Experience the extraordinary scale and beauty of Antarctica, where extended daylight allows for maximum time to explore. Each day brings new moments—watching whales from the bow, navigating channels teeming with seals, or walking among vast colonies of penguins. Witness the ship moving through pack ice, while expert guides deepen your understanding of this pristine, otherworldly environment and its remarkable wildlife.

DAYS 10-14

Drake Passage + Ushuaia + Buenos Aires

Watch as the coast of Antarctica disappears from view. Round the southernmost tip of South America and see the meeting of the Atlantic and Pacific Oceans. Disembark in Ushuaia and fly back to Buenos Aires, bringing your extraordinary journey exploring the White Continent to an end.

The Arctic & Nordics

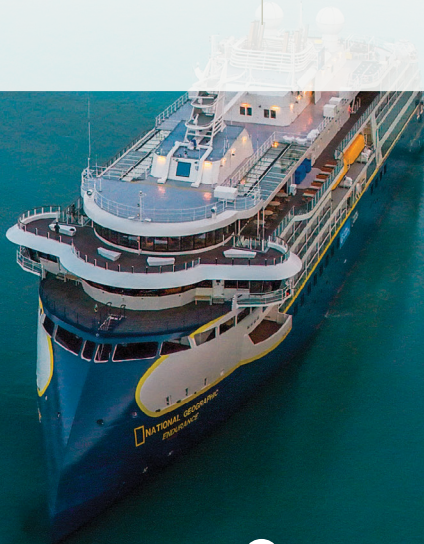
Offering a striking blend of wilderness and refined culture, the Arctic and Nordics are where dramatic landscapes meet folklore rooted traditions. From Iceland's volcanic terrain and cascading waterfalls to Norway's vast fjords, Greenland's immense icebergs and the remote reaches of Svalbard, this is a region defined by grandeur. Hike across glaciers and tundra under the Midnight Sun, and encounter polar bears, whales and walrus.

Peak Travel Periods

June–August is when sea ice recedes in the Arctic and expedition cruising becomes possible, offering access to remote fjords and optimal wildlife viewing.

Expert Advice

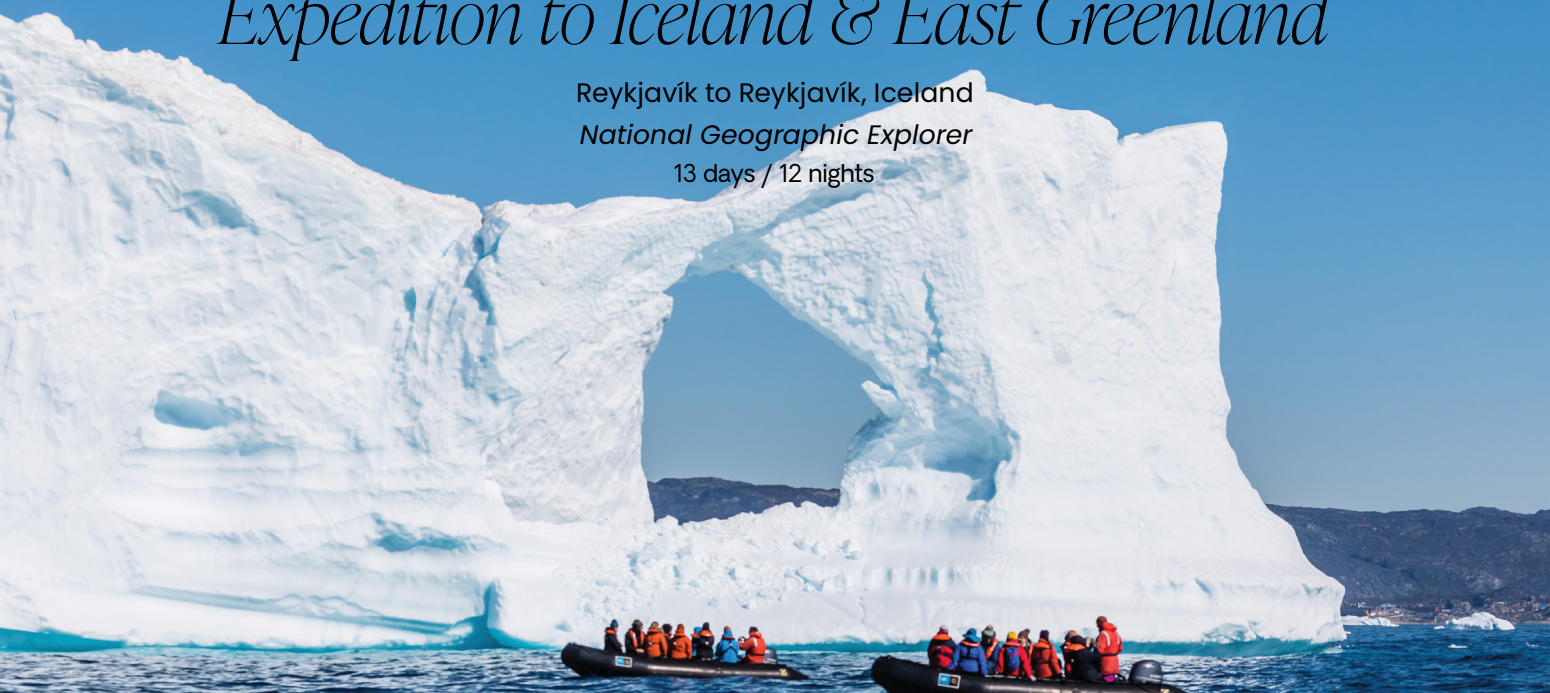
For wildlife and exploration, travel in **July–August** when conditions are at their most accessible. **May** and **September** can also be appealing for fewer crowds, though the weather is more variable and access to some regions may be limited.

Expedition to Iceland & East Greenland

Reykjavík to Reykjavík, Iceland

 13 days / 12 nights



DAYS 1-3

Reykjavík + Djúpvavík + Skagafjörður

Arrive in Reykjavík and embark on your expedition vessel, *National Geographic Explorer*. Cruise into the remote Westfjords, visiting historic Djúpvavík and its preserved herring factory. From the deck watch for the many whale species that inhabit these waters. Continue to Skagafjörður, where glacial landscapes, Icelandic horses and rich Viking heritage come to life through immersive cultural and nature-based experiences. Enjoy a gentle float trip along the Jökulsá River or visit a traditional turf farm to gain insight into rural Icelandic life.

DAYS 4-7

Greenland East Coast + Iceland Westfjords

Cross the Denmark Strait to remote East Greenland, where towering glaciers and dramatic fjords create a striking Arctic landscape. This region offers exceptional opportunities to explore dramatic fjords by Zodiac, kayak or on foot. As you journey through these pristine waters, spend time on deck, scanning for the region's unique wildlife. Keep watch for humpback and beluga whales, seals - and if you're lucky - the elusive narwhal or even a polar bear. Continue to Iceland's Westfjords, where you'll tour traditional eider farms, walk along boardwalks through puffin colonies, and cruise through serene fjords rich in birdlife and frequent whale sightings.

DAYS 8-10

Reykjavík + The Golden Circle

Disembark in Reykjavík and spend time exploring the charming city centre, visiting fascinating museums and wandering colourful streets, before immersing yourself in a new level of wellness at Sky Lagoon with the signature Skjól Ritual, a unique seven-step spa experience. Depart Reykjavík to explore Iceland's extraordinary volcanic terrain. Travel through the Hengill volcanic system, one of

the country's largest geothermal areas, and explore Iceland's iconic Golden Circle, discovering geysers, waterfalls and dramatic rift landscapes.

DAYS 11-13

Vatnajökull National Park + Vík + Reykjavík

Journey into Vatnajökull National Park, home to Europe's largest glacier, which covers nearly 14% of Iceland. Visit the breathtaking Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon, where icebergs drift across deep, tranquil waters, and continue to Vík and immerse yourself in Icelandic summer traditions. Conclude your journey back in Reykjavík, transferring to the airport for your onward departure, taking with you lasting memories of this extraordinary Land of Fire and Ice.



Expedition to Svalbard

Oslo, Norway to Longyearbyen, Svalbard

13 days / 12 nights



DAYS 1-3

Oslo + Longyearbyen

Welcome to Oslo, Norway's vibrant capital, where modern design, rich history and natural beauty come together. Visit the cultural Nobel Peace Center and Norwegian Royal Palace, take in sweeping fjord views from Aker Brygge or explore the atmospheric Kvadraturen. Depart Oslo by charter flight, enjoying sweeping Arctic vistas enroute to Longyearbyen. On arrival, embark on either *National Geographic Resolution* or *National Geographic Endurance* and set out into the Arctic.

Svalbard

Sail to the archipelago of Svalbard, one of the best places to see polar bears in their natural habitat. You'll also keep watch for walrus, reindeer, fur seals and the elusive Arctic fox. Explore in true expedition style, letting nature dictate the ship's day-to-day movements within an immense Arctic wilderness.

DAYS 4-10

Venture deep into the pack ice, and join spotters on the Bridge to scan the water for whales, including beluga, fin and minke. Sail into fjords and bays, where you can kayak among icebergs and dramatic mountains. On board, gain deeper insight into the mysteries of Svalbard as live footage from the Remotely Operated Vehicle (ROV) reveals the hidden world beneath the waters - up to 300 metres below.

DAYS 11-13

Longyearbyen

Disembark in Longyearbyen, a small coal-mining town on Spitsbergen Island, in Norway's Svalbard archipelago. Transfer to your Arctic retreat, Funken Lodge, a boutique hotel perched above the town with sweeping views of the fjord and surrounding mountains.

Tour Longyearbyen with a local driver-guide, gaining insight into the rich history, culture and distinctive way of life as you visit key landmarks, including the vast Adventdalen. Later, enjoy a memorable evening in a cosy, authentic cabin, gathering around a crackling campfire before returning to your hotel for the night.

Alaska & Canada

Alaska & Canada offer wild landscapes, global cities, and rich Indigenous cultures. Canada is renowned for its natural beauty, from the rugged peaks of the Rocky Mountains to the temperate rainforests of British Columbia. Indigenous heritage thrives across Alaska, where remote communities maintain deep cultural traditions. In these seldom-seen areas, you may witness the thunder of a calving glacier, kayak past foraging bears, or cruise alongside a pod of orcas.

Peak Travel Periods

June–August brings warm weather and superb wildlife viewing in Canada. Alaska's peak season runs from **July–August**, with long daylight hours ideal for cruising and exploration.

Expert Advice

In Alaska, glacier viewing is a highlight, with calving events most dramatic during the warmer midsummer months in **July** and **August**.

Vancouver, British Columbia to Sitka, Alaska

DAYS 1-3

Vancouver

Set between mountains and ocean, Vancouver offers a seamless blend of natural beauty and urban sophistication. Explore Stanley Park by bike and taste your way through Granville Island on a guided tour.

DAYS 4-5

Rocky Mountaineer

Spend the next two days onboard Rocky Mountaineer, with an overnight stay in Kamloops. Soak up the scenery from your glass-domed carriage while enjoying gourmet cuisine as you journey through the majestic Canadian Rockies to Jasper.

DAYS 6-7

Jasper + Lake Louise

Explore Jasper National Park, where you may encounter a variety of wildlife, such as bears, moose and elk, and sample local cuisine on a walking culinary tour. Then take a guided tour along the spectacular Icefields Parkway to Lake Louise, where breathtaking mountain and lake views await.

DAYS 8-10

Banff

Explore Moraine Lake, Yoho National Park and Emerald Lake, then discover Banff's highlights. Ascend to the summit of Sulphur Mountain for panoramic vistas of the Rocky Mountains. Transfer to Calgary for your flight to Seattle.

DAYS 11-13

Seattle + Juneau

Take a foodie tour of Pike Place Market before exploring Seattle's top attractions at your own pace. Fly to Juneau, where dramatic wilderness and small-town charm set the tone for your Alaskan

adventure as you board *National Geographic Venture*.

DAYS 14-16

Tracy Arm + Petersburg + Frederick Sound + Chatham Strait

Spend days exploring Alaska's remote fjords, witnessing towering glaciers, cascading waterfalls and abundant wildlife. Explore Petersburg's Norwegian heritage and unique ecosystems, then venture into Frederick Sound for sightings of orca and humpbacks, with opportunities for kayaking, forest walks and immersive wilderness experiences.

DAYS 17-20

Icy Strait + Glacier Bay National Park + Sitka

Cruise through Icy Strait, scanning the tides for sea lions and the skies for bald eagles. Spend a day exploring the scenery of Glacier Bay National Park. Disembark in Sitka and transfer to the airport for your onward journey.

DAYS 1-3

Sitka + Icy Strait

Embark your expedition vessel - the *National Geographic Venture* or *National Geographic Quest* - in Sitka and prepare for the journey ahead as you set out into the Inside Passage. 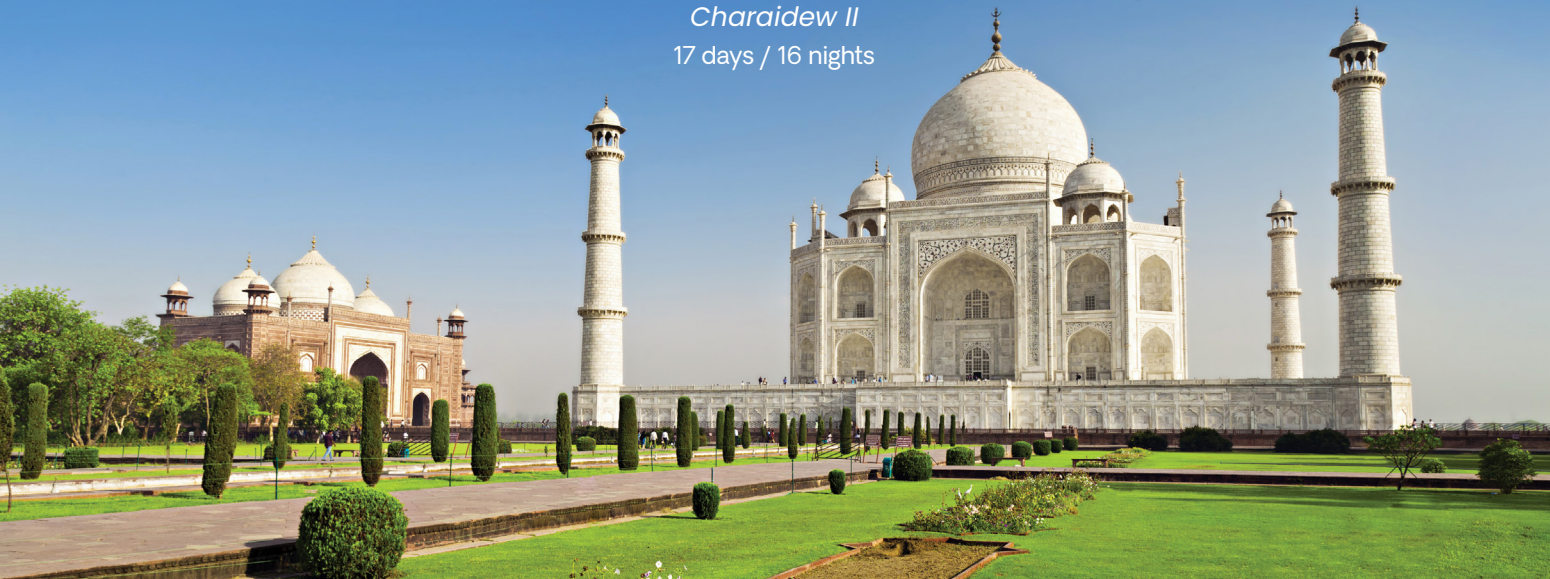
